

In 2022 95% of UCAS & CAO applicants were accepted onto their first choice of degree course. A sizeable number of students studying at Queen's University Belfast have chosen STEM degrees such as Biomedical and Biological Sciences, Midwifery, Electrical and Electronic Engineering, Software Engineering, and there is a notable increase in students electing to study degrees within the field of Mathematics. Within Arts and Humanities, applicants chose to study Social Work, Music, Sociology and PPE.

A large cohort of students began undergraduate studies at Ulster University with NHS career ambitions reflected in the number electing to study degrees in Allied Health, Nursing and Paramedic Science. Building Surveying, Construction Management, Architectural Technology and Quantity Surveying remain popular choices and with the expanding NI creative industries, there has been an increase in students applying to courses in Creative Technologies, Screen Production, Photography and Drama

Veterinary Science has featured strongly in past St Louis leaver's destination reports and this year we celebrate yet another student gaining a place at the school of veterinary science at the University of Liverpool.

Two students began their higher education journey in ROI. Their degree areas are Dentistry (Trinity College Dublin), and English & Media (University College Galway). After two years of Covid restrictions, there was an increase in applications to GB and student have commenced degrees in the following areas; Chemical Engineering at Loughborough, Environmental Geography at York, Geography at Brighton, Law at Dundee, Psychology and Youth Studies at Bangor, Management and Leadership at Nottingham, Teaching, Law, History, Psychology and Construction Management in Liverpool, Medical Sciences at Leeds, Nursing at East Anglia UEA and one student is undertaking a degree course in Air Transport combined with commercial pilot training at the University of Buckinghamshire.

Three students were delighted to achieve Higher Level Apprenticeships combining academic study with salaried employment and are now working and studying accounting, engineering and business operations and management.

The 2022 destinations reflect the diverse interests of our leavers, their individual academic strengths and skills, their ambition, diligence, resilience, and perseverance given the challenge of Covid.


